

All product suppliers under a "COLLECT" Transportation agreement must release their PO in the RONA OTM portal to schedule a pickup request.

If you do not have a RONA OTM account, please contact tms@rona.ca for set up.

### Purpose

This document outlines the RONA PO release procedure for product suppliers under a "COLLECT" Transportation agreement.

The RONA OTM portal is the portal to schedule a pickup request with the RONA transportation team.

The RONA PO release is required for all "COLLECT" PO shipments in Truckload (TL) or Less-Than-Truckload (LTL) quantities originating at a product supplier location delivering to RONA distribution centers & banner stores.

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## Connecting to the RONA OTM portal

You connect to the RONA OTM portal by entering the following URL into your web browser:

https://tms.rona.ca

When you get to the RONA OTM portal,

Enter your **user id** (TMS\_RONA\_xxxxx) and **password** to log into your account.

### Scheduling a Pickup request for a RONA PO

Pickup requests should be placed within the timeframe below:

Origin / Destination	Suggested Time to Book an Appointment					
From East to East & West to West,	At least 48 hours before the PO's due date.					
From the US to the same zone	At least 7 days before the PO's due date.					
(East/East, West/West)						
From the US to a different zone	At least 10 days before the PO's due date.					
(East/West, West/East)						
Between East and West Canada	At least 10 days before the PO's due date.					
From the Maritimes	At least 15 days before the PO's due date.					
Vendor Prepared Cross Dock	Add 4 business days to the above suggested					
Deliveries	times.					
RONA is not res	RONA is not responsible for late PO entries.					
Daily cut off for PO entry to be considered for next planning cycle; 2PM Eastern						

The Transport agent will closely monitor the deadlines to ensure compliance with delays.

Requests and pick up dates will be validated and confirmed by RONA transportation planner within 24 hours after the request has been sent.

The successful entry makes the PO visible for the RONA Transportation planning team.

### Modifying a Pickup Request

Once a PO has been successfully released in RONA OTM portal, the user does not have access to modify the data.

When a PO has been entered more than once, supplier **MUST** notify <u>tms@rona.ca</u> to have the erroneous entry removed.

Examples for modifications:

- Change of Source Location ID
- Modification of entered weight (weight amount or unit of measure (LBS/KG))
- Modification of pallet count
- Modification of number of pallet spaces (= floor spaces)

### Validation of successful PO release

After a successful PO release, the user can validate all released PO in the system by consulting the Order Release menu.

### Appendix

#### **Release Instruction:**

Always select Weight Amount, otherwise an error message will appear when saving the request.

#### Weight Amount:

Enter the weight amount of the merchandise.

#### Early Pickup Date:

Select the carrier pickup date: It is the date of availability for pick-up of the PO.

#### Pallets:

The number of pallet spaces must be superior to **0** and must be a whole number (Not a decimal), superior or equal to 1.

#### Commodity:

Classify the type of merchandise (Hazardous and/or Freezable):

#### **Pallet Spaces:**

Enter the number of floor spaces needed for the pickup request without exceeding the number of available floor spaces in a trailer (max 26 floor spaces).

For multiple orders on a same pallet space, example of 5 orders (PO) that are on the

same pallet space: when you enter related pickup requests, please enter the value (ex:0.2) in the Pallet Spaces field that reflects the portion used by each PO in this pallet space. Sum of entered values must be 1 (in this example).

#### To enter decimals, use a dot instead of a comma!

#### Ship with Group:

This field is NOT mandatory.

Enter unit number which corresponds to the shipment (trailer) created from the same list of orders (PO). This number can either be the trailer ID number or a supplier specific value. Suppliers who group in advance the orders (PO) in a same shipment (trailer) will use this field.
